This week our attendance has been 93.2%. The best attendance was 98.5% from Deer class. Well done to them!

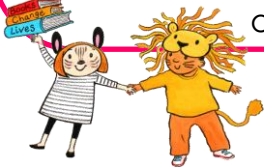


After School Clubs
