Please can we ask that parents/carers don't collect children until 3:15 pm as the playground is used for lessons by classes all afternoon.

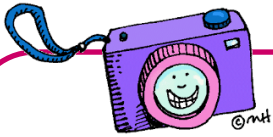
Guide Dogs for the Blind Fundraising
