This year the summer discos will be on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> July. Tickets will be on sale from the school office from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July.

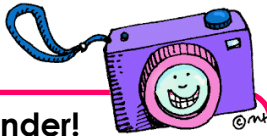


### Uniform
